While fall signals the last days of warm weather for much of the country, in Arizona it means the outdoor season is just beginning. One way to celebrate it is to spruce up outdoor furniture with all-weather fabrics, such as Perennials. This Dallas-based company specializes in textiles designed for use outdoors, and presents its offerings at perennialsfabrics.com.

The firm creates and manufactures numerous fabrics crafted from 100-percent solution-dyed acrylic fibers that are resistant to UV damage, soil and tearing, and are said to withstand at least three years of sun exposure without fading.

Under the Browse Categories link, one can search a virtual library of fabrics that includes velvets, sheers and umbrella-weight textiles, as well as designs that have the look and feel of raffia and terry cloth. Options in solids, stripes, plaids and florals are showcased. In addition, Perennials produces trims, tiebacks and pet beds from the durable fabrics.

The Color Wheel, a new addition to the Web site, allows users to choose a color and then peruse the textiles available in that shade. Consumers can either contact the company directly through the site or search for the nearest showroom that carries Perennials' fabrics. —SR
